Dick Whittington meets Blue Planet

Yet again, New Buckenham Players produce a fun-filled pantomime, and, to cap it all, fish floating around the hall, and a shark on the prowl! I was expecting David Attenborough to be appearing next in a cameo role as Dracula!

It was a wonderful evening's entertainment, with the full quota of corny jokes (how DO you spell COD - I never knew there was an F in cod), singing, dancing, double entendre, and the standard 'it's behind you' routines. As with any Clive Rush production, we got our money's worth of bangs and flashes, along with amazing sets. And, of course, all the traditional pantomime characters.

It was good to see Captain Cook (played by Roger Turner) back on stage again after a long absence, and I loved his sidekick Bosun Chips (ably played by Susie Clark), who always had a beaming smile and laugh. The whole cast were excellent and everyone contributed to make the evening's entertainment so good.

The film is based on the extraordinary true story of an unexpected friendship in the later years of Queen Victoria's rule. When Abdul Karim, a young clerk, travels from India to participate in the Queen's Golden Jubilee, he is surprised to find favour with the Queen herself. As Victoria questions the constrictions of her long-held position, the two forge an unlikely and devoted alliance with a loyalty to one another that her household and inner circle attempt to destroy. As the friendship deepens, the Queen begins to see a changing world through new eyes and joyfully reclaims her humanity.


