


### The 2023 Village Show

As I sit here writing this, the show seems almost a distant memory, but it was only three weeks ago. Thanks must go to everyone involved, entrants, visitors, lunchtime ladies, teatime ladies, Dr Mandy, Sue selling cards, and donors of raffle prizes. So many people and so much to do. But what a show!

Last year entrants and entries were well down on previous years, and we were worried that, like a lot of events, the time had come to cease as interest had been lost (as had two of our Village Shows due to lockdown). Last year we had only 114 entries and although this may seem a lot, compared to previous years this was well down. But no, this year we had 45 entrants who supplied 197 entries from vegetables to handicrafts and photos. This is an increase of 73% so there is life in the old dog yet. We had many new people entering and some from outside the village too. One told us he saw the advertising each day as he drove through the village and that inspired him and his family to take part.

Best in show was shared by Leslie Coulthard for her lemon cheesecake and Rachael Borenkova for her miniature flower arrangement. Well done to you both. The number of entries for the vegetable classes were well down but that was due to lateness of the show and the weather. Hopefully next year...

The high number of entries was boosted with flower arrangements and the handicrafts table, which overflowed with entries, the quality of which was very high according to the judge.

Dr Mandy ran her science club for the children and had over a dozen hiding under tables with torches making rainbows. Parents said it was an excellent idea to entertain the children whilst they viewed the entries and drank tea.

I must thank Rory Lester who stopped me in the street and volunteered to assist with the show and ended up doing everything for the photographic classes as our judge was unable to make it at the last minute. Also, Janet and Audrey who gathered unto themselves various prizes and ran the tombola for us. Thanks ladies.

So, it's on to next year and as it is an even numbered year we will be holding another Open Gardens event in June and the next Village Show is already booked for July 27th 2024. I bet you can't wait! (We haven't been able to arrange for the Red Arrows to open the show next year. Sorry!)

### **Community Car Service**

The community car service is provided by 'vetted' voluntary car drivers from the village, to enable those not able to access transport for non-emergency health-related journeys such as hospital/GP/ optician/dental or other health appointments. The journey fare is charged at 45p per mile with the service user paying half the cost direct to the driver with the other half paid out of a grant from Breckland Council and the Parish Council. We currently have seven volunteer drivers, including the co-ordinator.
